This Methodist tradition dates back to 1883, when women in Manchester collected £32 for missionary work overseas from 'Christmas pennies' at family gatherings on Christmas Day. An annual service of dedication is now held with all money raised through the Easter Offering going to the World Mission Fund of the Methodist Church in Great Britain for work in Partner Churches around the world. In 2023 this appeal raised over £190,000 nationally.
